

Thank You!

Thank you to all of you who donated or made pledges to donate this year to the roof fund. We are still far away from our roof fund goal of approximately \$116,496. The new roof has been installed. Metal roofing was put over the A-frame and a blown-on roofing system was used on the entire flat roof surface. We have you to thank for that. We depleted our Building Fund and Roof Fund money along with taking \$6,511.27 out of our General Fund to make our second payment of \$38,832. The final installment of \$38,832 will be due soon. Therefore, approximately \$45,000 still needs to be raised to pay back the General Fund to cover the roof expense. (Unfortunately, we also had fires in some of the overhead heating units in the hallways after we committed to the roof project which took away money that was in the Building Fund we were going to spend on the roof.) So, if you haven't donated vet or would like to make an additional donation to the Roof Fund you still can be a part of this great endeavor. Please mark your special offering "Roof Fund." Mission Project

On February 24, Russian forces invaded Ukraine launching land, sea and air attacks. More than five million people have fled their country to find refuge in neighboring countries. There are major humanitarian concerns for both internally displaced people and refugees. Many of the Ukrainians fleeing their homes need shelter and basic necessities. ELCA'S Lutheran Disaster Response (specifically, the Eastern Europe Crisis Response) is working alongside other humanitarian organizations to provide help to these people. We at Good Shepherd are supporting this effort by making it our mission project for the months of April, May and June. If you would like to give, send your donation made out to the church with the memo line marked "Ukraine" or use the offering plate on Sunday to place your cash donation in an envelope marked with "Ukraine" or with a check made out to the church with "Ukraine" on the memo line of a check. Your gifts to the ELCA's Lutheran Disaster Response ("Ukraine") will be used entirely (100%) to provide support for people impacted by conflict in the region.

We received a letter from the ELCA synod regarding the new COVID protocol. Currently, we are in the
"green" phase of the pandemic which means masks are not required indoors. Keith Kuttesch made the

We will make sure to let any lay worship leaders coming into the church know of our new mask policy.

CHURCH MATTERS:

- K'rin Fortuna, our church secretary, has resigned. Our organist, Evy Amerson, is interested in the
 position. Ruth Johns made the motion to hire Evy Amerson as our new church secretary at \$11 an hour
 for 10 hours per week. Terri Lombardo seconded. The motion carried.
- Ruth Johns made the motion to amend the insurance following the list that was sent out previously that
 the premium would be lowered except for the deductible that would stay at \$1,000. Keith Kuttesch
 seconded. The motion carried.
- Keith Kuttesch made the motion for Kristina Egetoe to use the fellowship hall for a graduation party on June 4th. Terri Lombardo seconded. The motion carried.
- Ruth John made the motion for Karen Esposito to use the fellowship hall from April 25 May 17 for her furniture sale. Fred DeDominicis seconded. The motion carried.
- We are going to ask an organist who has played at the church before to fill in for Evy while she is on maternity leave. If she is not able to play, Chuck Kennedy will check with Westminster College Music Department to see if any musician there is able to play.
- There will be a special meeting on April 20th, 2022 to go over the constitution.
- We discussed the well-being and the future of Good Shepherd.
- The fellowship hall will be blocked off from June 5 the end of July to prepare for the yard sale.
- The church swing set is broken in a few places, and we will look into fixing it or removing it.

PROPERTY:

- The roofers will be completing the roof soon now that the weather has improved.
- We are having drainage issues in the side yard near the classroom side of the building. Fred and his brother have offered to dig a ditch and insert a pipe to help alleviate the issue. Good Shepherd would only have to pay the cost of the materials. Fred will price the materials and get back to us.
