Council Highlights – Meeting held October 12, 2021

- This meeting was held virtually via Zoom.
- These minutes will be approved at the November Council Meeting.

CHURCH MATTERS:

- Pastor Goetze and a few members of the church met with Randall VanHorn to discuss an estimate for the sound system and audio streaming service for live streaming. He gave us an estimate of \$2,150.84 for the entire system.
- We will look into comparing our estimates and bring forth a recommendation to the congregation at the November congregational meeting.
- Terri Tankersly made the motion that we will contact Pastor Asplin and ask him to pursue a shared ministry between one or two other churches. Fred DeDominicis seconded. The motion carried.
- Terri Tankersly will preside over November's council meeting.

PROPERTY:

- Fred got a lawn mower for trimming around the church.
- Fred sealed the gaps between the pipe and the brick on the conduit near the side door by the pastor's office.
- Roofing Bids
 - Slagle Roofing & Construction \$32,000
 - PA Roof Restoration & Construction \$102,450. Bid for both flat roof & sanctuary roof, metal roof, and sealant to get us through the winter for free if we sign a contract with him. He will take \$3,500 off of each roof since we are a church. He bid in money to replace wet areas & if there are not any wet areas, he will take off that amount. If there are more wet areas than what he thought, he will not add money to the bid. Total = \$93,000
 - JB Commercial Roofing \$46,663 (20 Year PVC Membrane) & \$43,908 (15 Year Foam System)
 - We will get more information about the bids and make a decision at the next council meeting on which bid to present to the congregation.
- Fred shut the gas off to the stove because there was heat radiating from the burner.
