Communion through Trinity Episcopal

Although they continue to worship online, Trinity Episcopal church will be offering an in-person opportunity to receive Communion.

They will consecrate the elements on Sunday, during their online worship service, October 17th at 9:00 am. They will then set up two different times to distribute, on Saturday, October 16th. They will be at Trinity, New Castle from 9-11am and Resurrection, Hermitage from 1-3pm. Of course, masks and social distancing will be observed. This will be done in the upper parking lot. They are asking people to remain in their cars until (and if they would like it) they are ready to receive Communion - bread only. They are also offering during that time to pray for any prayer requests that folks may have. This will be done in 10-15 minute intervals to keep the line of cars moving. Also, you must register for this event so we know how many to expect and to avoid any bottlenecks in the parking lot. They are asking families, especially, to travel together, if possible.
